Class 2: E to J

Ethnic county of origin, FamilySearch.org, Find A Grave, Google searching for genealogy, Historical and genealogical societies, Immigration and Naturalization and passenger lists, Julian and Gregorian calendars

Class 3: K to P

Kinship relationships, Land records, Military and war records, National Archives and Records Administration, Oregon-state library, archives, records, Programs for genealogy, Probate records

Class 4: Q to U

Quaker, RootsWeb, Sources, State archives, Trees online, USGenWeb

Class 5: V to Z

Vital records, WVGS, Wiki, X signature, Your story, Zigzag!
