Class 2 A-E: Ancestry.com, Beginner's plan and forms, Census records, Ethnic

Class 3 F-G: Familysearch.org, Find A Grave (and other death records), Google Searching.

Class 4 This class will be dedicated to helping class members with their individual research questions.

Class 5 H-K: Historical/genealogical societies, Immigration/naturalization/passenger lists, Julian/Gregorian calendars, Kinships
