Excerpts From The *Woodburn Independent*

Excerpts from this early newspaper, published weekly or twice weekly in Woodburn, OR (about 16 miles north of Salem), primarily those including area residents' names and area activities. This information can be useful in establishing that those mentioned were in the area at the time. (Much of the 1890 Federal Census is missing.) *Some volumes are missing information from periods that are not in the microfilmed newspaper records in the Woodburn City Library.*
